Why should we plant pollinator friendly plants in our home gardens?

The David Suzuki Foundation says:

-  All creatures that eat plants (including humans!) depend on pollinators.
-  75% of the food we eat — fruits, nuts, vegetables, and herbs — need pollinators to reproduce.
-  Creating hospitable homes for beneficial insects in your garden means they are less likely to move into your house.
-  We have contributed to the decline of beneficial insects – we can help to bring them back
-  A garden that is alive with birds, bees and butterflies is more fun

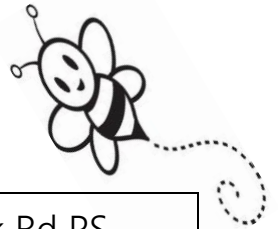
